

- required passage of a standardized National Teachers Examination for an education degree;
- a maximum of 12-15 credits of required undergraduate prerequisites for education-degree programs;
- and a program that would allow first-year public school

teachers to have one-year apprenticeships funded by the state.

These changes were to be put in place by the education departments at the University, Southern Oregon, Eastern Oregon and Western Oregon state colleges, and Portland State University by the fall of

1990.

The revised plans call for the addition of a new four-year interdisciplinary studies degree as an option for students who want to earn the extra five-year education degree.

The revised plans also include recommendations for:

- more in-classroom teacher

training for undergraduates and graduates in the education program;

- allowing education majors to pay undergraduate fees while earning fifth-year education degree;
- and integrating programs for special education teachers

into the proposed new regular education programs rather than requiring a sixth year for special education majors.

The revised plans call for the state college and university education departments to design the new programs by October 1989 and review them with the State Board.
