The Dinosaurs first played together in the summer of 1982 at the Waldorf nightclub in San Francisco as a single performance, bringing crowd reponse that warranted keeping the band together.

The has since performed more than 30 shows across the western United States.

The Dinosaurs' roster reads like a Who's Who of Sixties psychedelia. John Cipollina was a founding member of the Quicksilver Messenger Service. Spencer Dryden played drums with both the Jefferson Airplane and New Riders of the Purple Sage. Peter Albin was an original member of Big Brother and the Holding Company with Janet Joplin.

In addition, band members Barry Melton, who was the "Fish" in Country Joe and the Fish, and Merle Saunders teamed with Jerry Garcia in the SaundersGarcia Band.

The Dinosaurs will perform in Eugene along with Nine Days Wonder at W.O.W. Hall on Friday, May 15.
