The former "Spokane Sparrow" captured six NCAA titles in three consecutive years at 5,000 and 10,000 meters between 1966 and 1968.

plained. "But then it was Ryun and Shul, and people were talking about four minutes, and it got a lot bigger than I expected."

This year's Twilight classic did not wait until the final events of the evening to provide thrills and drama.

Oregon alumnus Kory

Tarpenning reached a new PR in the pole vault, soaring to 18-9 1/4. Tim Canfield managed 17-5 1/4, and finally qualified for the NCAA championship meet in June, becoming the 14th Duck this season to earn NCAA admission.

Redshirt freshman Eric Peterson, still burning from his disqualification against Oregon

State University the week before, burned the 1,500-meter track and made Dellinger's task of selecting 24 athletes for the Pacific 10 Conference championships next week even more difficult.

The Oregon coaches are now left with a dilemma. "Pete just added to our problem, but it's a

good problem. I don't see how we can keep him off the team, based on what he's done," Dellinger said.

Thirty-seven Ducks have qualified for the Pac-10 championship, and Dellinger is left with the unenviable task of selecting the two dozen who will make the trip to Corvallis.
