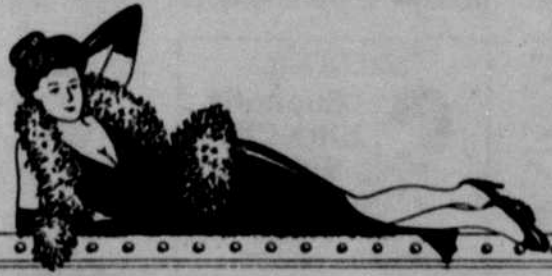

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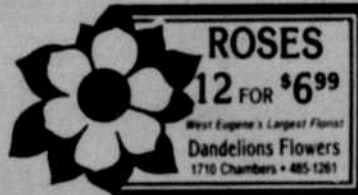

guess is she'll do six events in the conference meet."

Deavers goes in with the top marks in the 100, 200, and 400 meters, 100-meter hurdles and long jump.

Oregon's Penny Graves is not far behind, owning the fastest times in the 1,500, 3,000 and 5,000 meters. She's also met the NCAA standard in all three races. Along with Annette Hand, Oregon's other outstanding distance runner, Graves will compete in two events to better the Duck's chances of sneaking into the title picture.

"Graves, Hand and Jam-polsky are the potential winners and a whole lot of other (Oregon athletes)," said Heinonen, who

guided the Ducks to the NorPac conference championship last year. "If someone might catch (USC and UCLA), I'd like it to be us.

"We're going to put some points on the board. It's a matter of how much those solid performers can score in a meet as good as the Pac-10."

Horizontal jumper Julie Goodrich and thrower Yvette Brown are two Ducks who might give Oregon that needed boost. Just last week Goodrich made the NCAA elite, leaping to 20-10 in the Oregon Twilight. The week before, Brown got things clicking with a national qualifying discus mark (172-2).
