

Appropriate interview attire

Simple, gray and blue is best

Many graduating seniors are finally getting around to buying their caps and gowns. With less than 20 days until graduation, many, too, are looking past their tassels of security at the uncharted realm of the job world — and how to dress for it.

Above all, the main thing to keep in mind is to keep it simple.

The conservative look will be your best bet in impressing an interviewer and landing a good job. The conservative look means gray and navy blue.

It's not a loud look, but it says a lot when you wear it into an important interview. It says you're dedicated and serious about the job you want and it also shows you're receptive to the attitudes of those around you.

Black, although formal, is too intimidating and stern. It communicates an unapproachable attitude to your interviewer, and this person is the one who decides whether you get the job — usually within the first 30 seconds of the interview.

Bright colors hint of frivolity and a carefree attitude. This is fine when you are on your own time, but in a professional setting, you need to be taken seriously.

"Depending on the job applied for, most people require a dark dressy suit," says Fred Peterson of the Boardroom, located at 101 E. Broadway in Eugene.

Men should look at gray slacks of natural fibers, chiefly wool or wool blends with synthetics and a complementary

jacket of similar fabric in a navy blue.

The jacket should not be baggy, rather it should have a clean fit in the shoulders and the sleeves should break at the wrist just below the base of the thumb. Trousers can either be pleated or flat, but they should hang clean and not buckle more

than once or twice on the shoe. "Three-piece suits are a thing of the past. Perhaps if you are applying for a CPA or a stockbroker position, but not for most white-collar jobs," Peterson says.

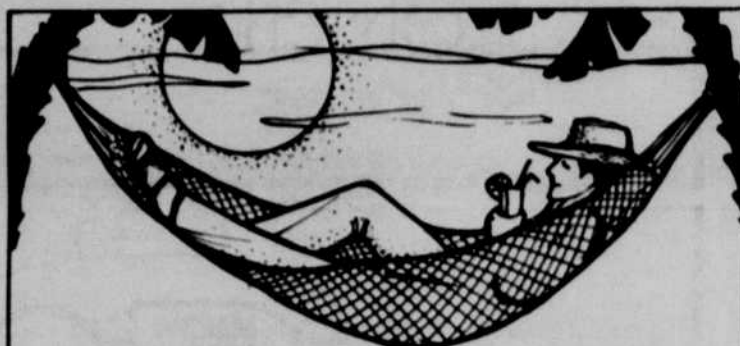
