reversed (gray jacket and blue trousers), or unified (all navy or all gray suit), but the blue over gray set-up is the most common.

Ties and shirts should not compete with the outfit. A burgundy tie and a white dress shirt is a no-fail match.

These tips on color and fabric hold true for women as well, with a few exceptions.

Johnna Espinoza of Place

Two's Women's Department at Valley River Center explains that the conservative look is the one that works.

"First impressions matter. Look polished and well groomed. A good conservative outfit starts with a basic two-piece suit, either navy or gray," she says.

Skirts should stop on the calf where the muscle comes into the knee, accenting slimness.

Skirt length varies with trends and this fit is the safest all-around. Jackets should fall either above or below the widest part of the hip, but never on it.

Also, women should avoid distracting jewelry and colored stockings because they compete with the conservative theme. Avoid wearing ties and stick to a white blouse.

"Don't wear dangling earrings or three or four bracelets on

your wrists. You don't want to wear jewelry that makes noise. Wear small pearl earrings or maybe a fine gold chain bracelet. Those are much more appropriate for an interview," Espinoza says.

Both Peterson and Espinoza point out that dressing down, avoiding loud and abrasive styles, is the key to moving up. Once you have worked the job for a while and proved yourself

as a professional, you can get a little more creative in your dress.

"Don't wear plaids or browns. Dress as new and up-to-the-minute as you can without getting too bright," Peterson says.

Espinoza says, "Styles for women are going away from the 'power-dress' look. The goal is to look neutral, to look professional."
