P.S. Send money.

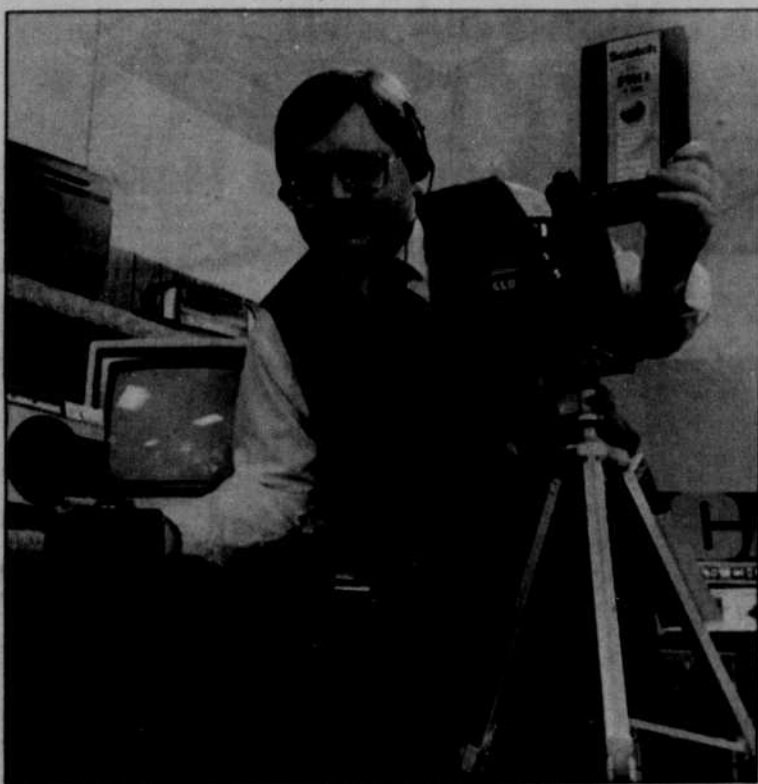


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Tracy Gardner of A&R Electronics and Appliances displays some possible gifts for graduates, including a camera and video cassette.

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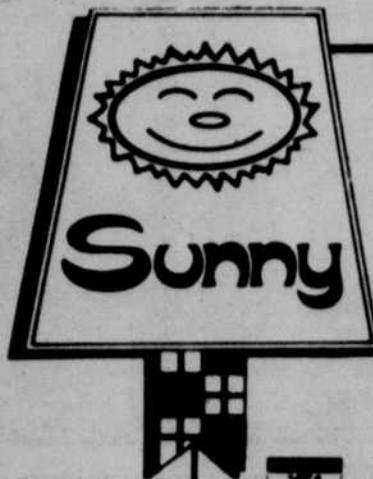
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
