For Harper's Magazine he published "Baseball and the American Character" and "Tom Seaver's Farewell." After the 1978 World Series, he wrote "Recall, as the Series Ends, the

Afternoon of the Fall," for the Hartford Courant. The Boston Globe featured two of his articles: "A Ballpark is Freedom's Ring" and "A Magic Game and an End to Innocence."

For the New York Times, he wrote "Men of Baseball, Lend an Ear."

That was in 1981.

By 1986, when he became National League president, that

Times admonition became a mandate for teams playing in stadia from New York to San Diego.

On June 14 at Autzen Stadium, it will be an opportunity for Oregon's men and women of the Class of 1987.
