# Pre meet still turns out a Classic

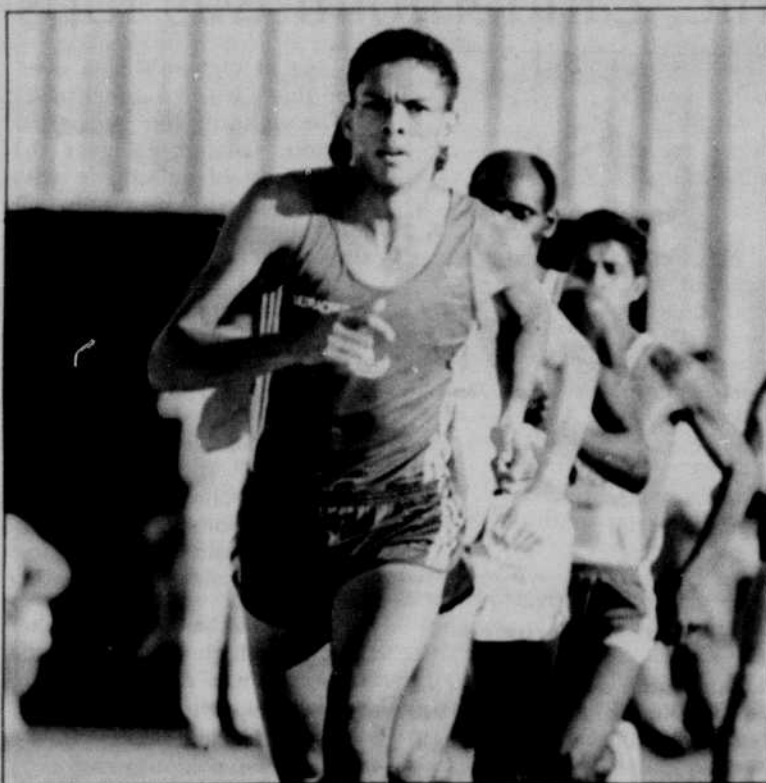

On a night where records none were set, competitive racing and nostalgia still entertained the throng of 7,043 who turned out for the 13th annual Prefontaine Classic at Hayward Field Saturday night.

At the meet's conclusion, fans lined up for one last trek around the Hayward track before renovation began Sunday, a process which unofficially started after the meet when those most resilient in the renovation backing took a pick to the surface.

In one of the headliners, former Oregon trackster and 1984 Olympic 800-meter gold medalist Joaquim Cruz did not crack the 3:50 barrier for the mile but still outlasted Chuck Aragon and Dub Myers to win in 3:56.32. A strong headwind and slow pace probably prevented the Brazilian from breaking Jim Ryun's 20-year-old American standard of 3:51.26.

A realistic Cruz said afterward it was probably too early in the season to set such a mark, and was still pleased with his efforts, anyways. "I'm very pleased," he said. "I'm coming back and I just need to race some more."

In the 5,000 meters, it was mainstay Doug Padilla turning back miler Steve Scott at the tape in 13:30.20, an American best for the year, to Scott's 13:30.39. In a display of mutual respect after the race, both expressed desires to cut the time down to the 13:20's, but once again the wind served up the field's most looming opponent. Scott, who has not run a 5,000 since 1979, was certainly the most impressive of the talent-laden 24-man field, and may have been nipped at the tape by Padilla's experience alone.

"It's just a matter of learning the race," Padilla said.

"I have to get in front of him the last 200 meters," Scott said in retrospect. "Chasing Doug is very tough. He's a tough competitor and stubborn down that home stretch."

Although other races took the backseat in attention, they proved just as competitive nonetheless. Former Duck and
