# ASUO plans summer work activity

The ASUO Executive plans to keep active throughout the summer with hiring, ASUO insurance, child care, and a United States Student Association conference in August.

ASUO President Kasey Brooks said she will be busy with applications, meeting with search committees and interviewing to fill the ASUO legal

services position announced earlier this month, as well as finding an ASUO executive coordinator.

This will be the first time in several years the executive coordinator position will be put up for a search, Brooks said. In the past, there has been an agreement between outgoing and incoming ASUO executives not to do a job search for the position, which currently is held by Susan Sowards, she added.

ASUO Vice President Karen Gaffney said the search committee may end up filling the position with the same person, but this is "a technicality to prove we have the best person in that position."

Brooks said she hopes to complete interviewing for the executive coordinator position by the end of June. Interviewing for the legal services position, now held by attorney Karsten Rasmussen, will take place in mid-July, Brooks added.

Aside from hiring, the Executive will tour the EMU child care facilities later this week to survey possible maintenance problems. It also hopes to raise awareness of child care issues with the University administration and faculty, Gaffney said.

The summer insurance committee, comprised of Brooks, Gaffney, and Chairman Jim Chesebrough, will work out details with the new insurance carrier, the American College Health Association and Prudential Life Insurance. Ironing out details in time for fall registration will keep them busy, Brooks said.


