Illinois names Voelz as finalist

The University's Associate Athletic Director Chris Voelz is one of four finalists for the athletic director position at Illinois State University, the athletic department confirmed on Wednesday.

Voelz, who has worked at Oregon since 1978, is a 1970 graduate of Illinois State and a member of that school's athletic Hall of Fame. She received her masters degree from Northern Illinois University in 1974.

Before assuming duties as associate athletic director in October 1985, Voelz worked as assistant director of athletics and women's volleyball coach for eight years. She amassed a coaching record of 187-166-11, which included an NCAA tournament appearance in 1984.

Her current responsibilities include oversight of internal organization and management, regional and local sports, and drug testing policy and procedure. She is also a member of the NCAA Post-Season Drug Testing Committee.

Athletic director Bill Byrne is on vacation and could not be reached for comment. Assistant Sandy Walton, senior administrator in the absence of Byrne and Voelz, said, "We would certainly hate to lose her. She has been instrumental in making a lot of positive changes."

"It would be quite a coup for her to get the job," Walton continued. "Based on her past performance she would make an excellent choice. She is extremely capable and a tireless worker," Walton added.

Voelz flew to Illinois for an interview earlier this week and was unavailable for comment.
