Osborn selected to play in overseas PAC-10 competition

Oregon guard Rick Osborn is one of 10 players selected from the Pacific Athletic Conference to represent the PAC-10 on an all-star basketball team that

begins a six-game series in England Aug. 13.

The PAC-10 All-Stars will play six games in 12 days on English soil. First-year head

coach Kelvin Sampson from Washington State University will coach the squad, which includes one player from each conference school.

A total of three athletes from the state of Oregon traveled abroad with the team, more than from any other state represented in the conference.

In addition to Osborn, who is from Portland, UCLA guard Dave Immel, from Hillsboro and OSU forward Bill Sherwood from Corvallis, are Oregonians on the team.

Rounding out the All-Stars' roster are University of Arizona forward Anthony Cook, University of Southern California forward Chris Munk, University of California center-forward Hart-

mut Ortmann, WSU forward Brian Quinnett, University of Washington guard-forward Jeff Sanor, Arizona State University guard Arthur Thomas and Stanford University forward-center Howard Wright.

Oregon trainer Rich DeChellis also was selected to travel with the team.

This marks the fourth time in five years that the PAC-10 has sent an all-star team overseas. The 1986 team enjoyed an eight-game unbeaten series against teams from Scandinavia, and the Pac-10 currently has a nine-game winning streak against international competition.

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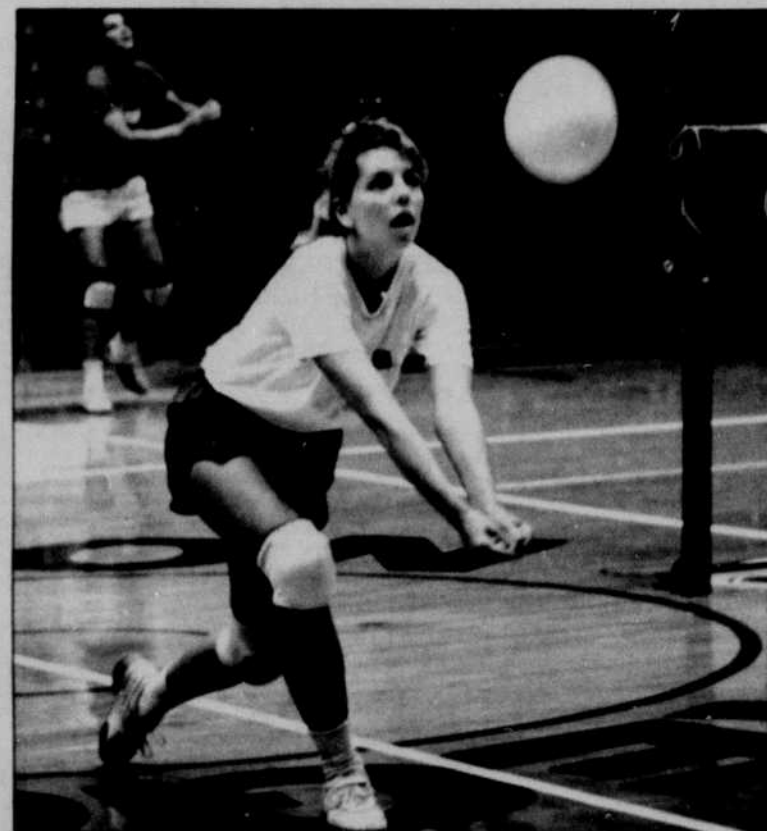

Although the Oregon women's volleyball team has every reason to expect success during the 1987 season, it is taking nothing for granted.

The Webfoot spikers were the only fall sports team to see NCAA-tournament action a year ago, and they were the first one to begin practice for the upcoming season when second-year coach Gerry Gregory called his troops together Aug. 3 to begin preparations for their Sept. 1 opener, at Northwestern University.

Led by senior All-American candidate Teri Kramer, the Ducks return all six starters and all but two players from the team that went 22-12 and hosted a first-round NCAA-tournament match last season.

Kramer led the nation in kills a game last season, and set an Oregon single-season record with 703 put-aways. This season Kramer, with 1,400 career kills, has an outside shot at breaking former All-American Sue Harbour's school and NCAA record of 2,099.

The Ducks finished last year ranked 15th in the nation by both the NCAA and Tachikara/Collegiate Volleyball Coaches Association polls, but managed only a fourth-place finish in the Pacific-10 Conference. The PAC-10 traditionally is one of the nation's most competitive volleyball conferences, and five teams were ranked in the Top 20 a year ago.

Oregon opens its schedule with eight consecutive road dates, including tournaments featuring NCAA Final Four participant Nebraska and highly rated San Diego State.

Other players who should make an impact this year are sophomores Michele Krebsbach and Stephanie Snyder, and senior Monica Camp.

Krebsbach was named the conference's top freshman last season, and ranked sixth nationally in kills a game. Snyder joined Krebsbach on the PAC-10 all-freshman squad, and led the nation with an average of 13.2 sets per game.

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
