'Historic' motif to highlight Fifth Avenue

A local construction company has begun the first of several improvements to create a historic theme for Eugene's Fifth Avenue area.

"The project is under construction right now and will continue through September," said Rich Weinman, community development coordinator for the Eugene Development Department.

"However, the lights won't be installed by that time. The

lights are on order and may be delayed," Weinman said. The lights will match those installed on the downtown Broadway Street project this summer, he said.

Wildish Corvallis Construction Co. will build on the north side of Fifth Avenue between Willamette and Pearl streets.

"It's a city of Eugene beautification project which will cost \$109,878," according to Sandra Gleason, public information officer for the city of Eugene public works department.

The project was initiated by an ad hoc committee for Fifth Avenue improvements, Gleason said.

The committee is constructing curbs, gutters, a 10-foot sidewalk and is going to install landscaping, Gleason said. "The lighting and the tree wells are planned around a historic theme," she added.

The city will provide 13 Pagoda trees, which will be planted later this year during the fall planting season, Weinman said.
