

# University student drowns; funeral today

A University student drowned Sunday at Crescent Lake, Oregon State Police said.

Michael John Klotter, 19, of Eugene, was attempting to swim to shore with two friends from a small wooden boat when he began struggling in the water and went under. One of Klotter's friends attempted to keep Klotter afloat but lost his grip and Klotter slipped beneath the waters, said Sgt. Jim Hand, of the Klamath Falls branch of the state police.

Klotter's body was recovered Monday morning by a search and rescue team from the Klamath County sheriff's office, Hand said.

The incident was reported to the Klamath County sheriff's of-

fice at 12:10 a.m. and then referred to the state police at 12:20 a.m. Monday, Hand said.

The drowning has been ruled accidental although alcohol was involved in the incident, Hand said. The three had been staying at a cabin owned by one of their parents. The lake is located southeast of Oakridge off State Highway 58.

According to the University News Bureau, Klotter had completed his freshman year at the University. He resided at Caswell Hall and was enrolled as a pre-major. He was a 1986 graduate of Churchill High School.

"He was well-liked by a lot of people in the dorms," said Patrick Short, a resident assistant in Caswell Hall during the

1986-87 school year. "He was a very nice guy, and he got along with everyone really well."

"He was a quiet kind of person," Short said.

According to Short, Klotter and his roommate "were the characters of the floor yet he wasn't very loud. He was always very quiet, always in the background."

"I saw a lot of growth in him. He matured through the year," he said.

Klotter is survived by his parents, Thomas and Madelyn of Eugene; brothers, Tom of Phoenix, Ariz., and Donald of Eugene; grandmother, Ann Bosshart; and numerous other relatives. Mass of Christian Burial will be today at 2:30 p.m. at St. Mary's Catholic Church.

ed, Yamanaka said.

"The painters have procedures to follow like everyone else, and there is nothing that can be done about it. We want a track we can be proud of for years and you don't get that by slapping down paint," he said.

Workers broke ground on the project immediately after the conclusion of the last track meet of the 1987 season, the Prefon-


taine Classic, so they could not have started work any earlier.

Yamanaka said changes in the project midway through construction, like moving the finish line in front of the bleachers and moving the starting line of the 100-meter sprint, also had con-

tributed to the delay.

Anderson seemed agitated by the last-minute change in venue, but withheld comment. "I would rather not go public with my feelings on this issue right now," he said from his OTC office Tuesday.

UNIVERSITY OF OREGON REQUIREMENTS FOR AIDS PREVENTION POSTER COMPETITION 1987



Participants are asked to turn in a finished piece of artwork with their choice of technique (e.g. painting, watercolor, lithograph, silkscreen, etching, etc.). The winner's design will be photographically reproduced for a printed poster.

The chosen artist will be awarded \$100.00. All rights to the poster become the property of the University of Oregon Student Health Center.

**Poster size:** The size of the poster is suggested to be approximately 17 1/4 by 24 inches, with the visual image being approximately 15 1/2 by 15 1/2 inches, with the lettering below image using approximately 8 inches. There will be approximately a 3/4 inch border all the way around.

**Lettering:** The purpose of the poster is to raise awareness of AIDS and AIDS prevention for the University of Oregon community. Lettering needs to give the following information:

**UNIVERSITY OF OREGON, STUDENT HEALTH CENTER**

**Image:** Should have some relevance to AIDS awareness or AIDS prevention.

**Submission requirements:** The work should be fastened to a hard backing (cardboard, coreboard, etc.) and covered with a removable acetate sheet. No frames or glass, please

**Deadline:** The finished art is to be submitted no later than Thursday, **October 8** to: James K. Jackson, MD, University of Oregon, Student Health Center, 1590 E. 13th, Eugene, OR 97403. For information or details please contact Sherrie McArthur at 686-4447.

The works will be judged by the Educational Sub Committee of the University of Oregon AIDS Task Force Committee. The winner will be publicly announced by October 12, 1987. The committee reserves the right to extend the deadline if an appropriate poster has not been submitted by that date.

**Availability of Posters:** Posters should be available for sale by December 1, 1987. Any proceeds from the sale of these posters will be donated to local organizations for AIDS education.

**Price:** The price of the poster has been tentatively set at \$5.00.
