Balladeer recently moved to the ground floor portion of the Fifth Street Public Market, and Davie said all of the stores' material is new, but he was "looking to get some used CDs in."

The store, which also has a variety of fine acoustic musical instruments, is open every day

from 10 a.m. until 6 p.m., and 10 to 9 on Fridays.

Cat's Meow Jazz and Blues Corner, 207 E. Fifth Ave. (Fifth Pearl Building, Suite 111), is packed with jazz and blues, gospel, cajun, and raggae music in CDs, records and tapes. Open 10 a.m. until 5:30 p.m. Monday through Saturday, and noon to

5 p.m. Sundays.

Record Garden, 957 Willamette St., was formerly located on W. 11th. For students looking for the ultimate in rock, heavy metal, and imported music, the Record Garden has what they want.

The store carries all types of music, says owner Mike McAdams, but has a large selection of rock from the 1950s and 60s, and definitely the widest selection of imports in town.

"Right now, we're working with 30 companies, including 13 import and 12 front-line American companies," McAdams said.

"We have a lot of the obscure groups, and we carry things that have been out of print in this country for years," he said, listing England, France, Holland, and Japan among the

many countries that the Record Garden receives imports from.

The Record Garden is unique in that albums outsell tapes and CDs, "something not too common," says McAdams. The store also offers a wide variety of shirts and posters for the avid rock and heavy metal fan.

Store hours are 10 a.m.-9 p.m. Monday-Saturday, and noon-6 p.m. Sundays.

Musicland, located at 62 W. Broadway Ave., Fifth and Willamette and 273 Valley River Center, recently replaced Earth River Records and Tapes and Everybody's after buying out Marathon Music, which owned Earth River and Everybody's.

Assistant Manager Glen Stohr says Musicland carries "more compact discs than anyone in the Eugene area."

Musicland has all types of music, says Stohr, who adds that the store has a wide variety of music accessories, such as shirts, posters, record and tape

care products, "boom boxes," walkmans, and blank audio and video tapes.

Musicland's Fifth and Willamette location boasts a large selection of movie video rentals. Musicland is open 10 a.m.-9 p.m. Monday-Saturday, noon-6 p.m. Sundays.

For those looking for a more thorough selection of used records and tapes, the House of Records at 258 E. 13th Ave. buys, sells and trades used records, tapes and CDs.

Mr. Mike's, 223 W. 7th Ave., offers a large variety of used records and tapes, specializing in rock. The store also carries hundreds of used singles, plus buttons and posters. Mr. Mike's hours are Monday through Saturday, 11 a.m. until 6 p.m.
