The Book Fair, at 1409 Oak St., is advertised as a "browser's paradise." You'll find new and used books on history, cooking, sports, and science, along with children's books. The store also has old National Geographics for as low as 30 cents each. The Book Fair is open Monday through Saturday.

The Book Mark, located at 856 Olive St., offers books on a wide variety of topics, including a large selection of children's and computer books. The store also carries general and special interest magazines and out-of-town newspapers.

Store hours are 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. Monday through Friday, 9:30 to 5:30 Saturday, and noon to 5 p.m. on Sundays.

B. Dalton Bookseller, at 194 W. Broadway on the Eugene Mall, is an all-purpose nationwide chain bookstore which carries many volumes, according to owner Pat Chupa. "Our biggest sections are fiction, science fiction, and literature," she said.

The store has over 25,000 volumes. "40,000 at Christmas," Chupa said. B. Dalton's is open seven days a week.

The Literary Lion, located at

Number One Centre Court, 44 W. Broadway, is a general book store which also carries maps and greeting cards.

Owner Bill Sweet describes his store as "a general bookstore (for all ages) with a large selection of children's, sports, Oregon and Northwest books."

The store has about 25,000 titles, and is open seven days a week.

J. Michaels Books, located at 160 E. Broadway in the Quackenbush Building, is an "antiquarian bookstore," says owner Jeremy Nissel, "which
