Plaza, is a small but interesting place to get a good, cheap breakfast. Although generally not frequented by the student population, this real coffee shop is a hidden goldmine for those seeking an affordable breakfast at a slow-paced, high-style diner.

Located about two blocks south of Hoot's, the Hult Plaza Coffee shop is similar to Hoot's in terms of style, but much smaller. With only five booths, three tables, and a coffee counter, the restaurant has the ability to serve good food on a personal level.

The food is priced modestly but the portions are large. And

the coffee is brewed frequently and served up fresh.

The restaurant has Eugene written all over it; it is the type of place where people read the Register-Guard, not the Oregonian, with breakfast.

Aesthetically, the restaurant's decor is almost surreal. With neat yellow napkin holders at each table, ugly oil paintings with big wood frames on the wall, and a confined overall look, the Hult Plaza Coffee Shop is the type of place where people who collect salt and pepper shakers hang out.

The coffee house has some delicious food items, including fresh strawberry pie, diced ham

and scrambled eggs, and daily specials.

Viewing the place from an aesthetic perspective, the Hult Plaza Coffee Shop is the most appealing place on or near campus to have breakfast.

The Glenwood Restaurant, located at 1340 Alder St., the Excelsior Cafe, at 754 E. 13th Ave.; the Book and Tea Shop, located at 1646 E. 19th Ave.; and the restaurants in the EMU are all excellent places not only for coffee drinking, but for eating as well.
