If the trend of losing to nationally ranked teams continues, the Bears are in trouble.

The Ducks moved up one slot in the Tachikara/AVCA poll, from 12th to 11th, but remained 12th in the NCAA ranking.

Adolph said it may be harder for Oregon to move up in a national ranking than it is for a Stanford or UCLA.

"There's really no pressure

on us right now," she said. "Other teams are saying, 'it's Oregon, they're just getting lucky.' " She added that the team is having no problem getting up for nationally-ranked teams every week.

"It's never tough to get up for anybody. Every game has been a

big game for us. We're still the underdogs."

Adolph is 18th in the nation in assists, with 11.0 per game. Oregon middle blocker Lauri Krejcha is second nationally in block average (2.06).

As far as team goals are concerned, Gregory said the Ducks

are ahead of schedule.

"I would have liked for us to have won our early games (Oregon opened the season with three straight losses), but then we won some Pac-10 games and that brought us back. Our goal is still to finish in the top three in the conference."
