

It was an especially rocky afternoon for senior flanker Rod Green. Green prepped at nearby Palo Alto High School, and was named a team co-captain despite being hobbled with a game leg.

After the toin coss, however, Green was not a factor. He did catch two passes for 11 yards, but both his receptions came on third down plays, and neither produced first-down yardage.

Sophomore punt return specialist Terry Obee is watching a dream season develop into a recurring nightmare on special teams. The conference's secondleading punt returner, Obee fielded a 56-yard Dave Robison boot at his own three-yard line, then retreated into the end zone for a safety and Stanford's first points of the afternoon five minutes into the third quarter.

The Oregon ground attack faltered badly after Berry left the game. The Ducks managed just 96 yards on 42 rushing attempts.

Only redshirt freshman Tony Hargain, who had fired mostly blanks in his first season, burst out of his shell down on "The Farm," snaring six catches for 82 yards and the Ducks' lone touchdown.




