safety as the Oregon bandwagon comes to a lurching, grinding halt.

"We've got to go back and work on the basics, work on protecting the ball and take it one game at a time," said Toledo.

The Ducks should be favored in at least two of their remaining contests, against California (1-5-1, 0-2-1) and Oregon State (2-5, 0-3).

There was plenty of fault to be found in Saturday's debacle. Musgrave performed courageously, but Billy the Kid's six-shooter had a few empty chambers.

Senior J.J. Birden did not play because of an ankle injury sustained the week before. Fullback Latin Berry left the game early in the first quarter with a severe cut on his left hand that required stitches, and did not return.

It was an especially rocky afternoon for senior flanker Rod Green. Green prepped at nearby Palo Alto High School, and was named a team co-captain despite being hobbled with a game leg.

After the coin toss, however, Green was not a factor. He did catch two passes for 11 yards, but both his receptions came on third down plays, and neither produced first-down yardage.

Sophomore punt return specialist Terry Obee is watching a dream season develop into a recurring nightmare on special teams. The conference's second-leading punt returner, Obee fielded a 56-yard Dave Robison boot at his own three-yard line, then retreated into the end zone for a safety and Stanford's first points of the afternoon five minutes into the third quarter.

The Oregon ground attack faltered badly after Berry left the game. The Ducks managed just 96 yards on 42 rushing attempts.

Only redshirt freshman Tony Hargain, who had fired mostly blanks in his first season, burst out of his shell down on "The Farm," snaring six catches for 82 yards and the Ducks' lone touchdown.
