

# 'PM Magazine' in Portland will showcase University

## Four colleges featured during Homecoming Week

As part of "PM Magazine's Homecoming Week," the University will be one of four Oregon colleges featured on the Portland television program "PM Magazine."

The program's two hosts, Jack McGowan and Elaine Busby, accompanied by a camera crew, will be in Eugene Thursday to begin filming what will be a week of programming broadcast from the University, Oregon State University, Linfield College and Willamette University.

"Basically...we're going to find out what kind of spirit each

one of the schools has. What we'll do down there is we'll highlight the Civil War game that will be going on November 21," producer Polly Collins said.

The crew will arrive at 10 a.m., when they will be greeted at the Erb Memorial Union by the Duck mascot and the rally squad. From there, Collins said that McGowan, Busby and the camera crew will wander around campus during the day, randomly selecting students to interview for the program.

"We'll go around campus and ask people, you know, what

do they think about the Ducks versus the Beavers," she said.

The show will be aired November 9 on KGW in Portland and in other parts of Oregon and Washington.

Eugene's NBC affiliate, KMTR-TV, does not carry the program as a part of its pro-

gramming schedule, so Eugene residents without cable who wish to see the program may be out of luck. TCI cable television shows the program at 7:30 every weeknight on Channel 28.

The University will be the first of the colleges featured during the show's "Homecom-

ing Week," but not all of the program will focus on the school. Collins said that "PM Magazine" often broadcasts from different places.

"What we do is we go to different locations every night, and so that night we'll be at U of O and we'll introduce stories from that location. They don't necessarily have to do with U of O, but we use it as a backdrop."
