Library's fight for space an old war

The University's main library is 50 years old this year, let's celebrate! As a part of this week's Homecoming events, the University will be rededicating the state's largest

collection of books and the only research library in Oregon, in honor of its 50 years of existence. The library's history reflects the growth of the University.

Although the University's main library is over 1.4 million volumes richer and 147,000 square feet larger than it was 50

years ago, the library still looks much as it did when its doors first opened the morning of May 3, 1937.

Library rededication slated

For 50 years the University's Main Library has been the cornerstone of providing literature and information to the campus community. On Saturday, a rededication ceremony will mark the library's golden anniversary.

In concurrence with homecoming festivities, the rededication will begin at 9:30 a.m. in front of the library's main entrance. University President Paul Olum will be the first speaker. Other speakers include Chancellor William Davis of the Oregon State System of Higher Education, ASUO President Kasey Brooks and University Professor of art history Leland Roth.

University Librarian George Shipman will read the memoirs of Gordon Gilke, a faculty member of the Oregon Art Institute, who as a University student made drawings of the library's construction for his master's thesis.

A public reception featuring a balloon release and a cake sculpted in the image of the original 1937 library building will immediately follow the rededication.

Those attending the ceremony will be encouraged to tour the library. Photographs taken at the time of the library's completion half a century ago will be on exhibit.

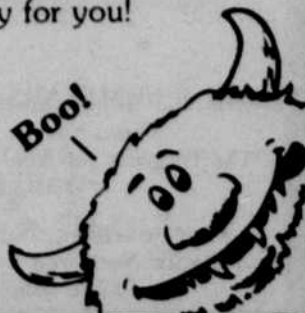
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
