"Cigarette of A Lonely Man" is also one of those story songs for which Squeeze is famous. Writing a realistic song about the life and loves of a single man, Difford and Tilbrook create an interesting everyday picture:

*Striking matches getting a flame on the stove  
There's some of her hair in the teeth of my comb,  
dirty clothes piled up on the bathroom floor...*

It's as real as it gets. But it's also real in another aspect--loneliness.

*The cigarette of a single man  
burns in the ashtray by his bed,  
he pulls the ring of another can  
and holds it up beside his head.  
The book he reads is on the floor,  
he's read it several times before.*

*Whats you got to go home to?*

"Some Americans," the album's lyrical highlight, presents an interesting look at the people and politics of this land:

*Some Americans are very pretty  
Some Americans are very shy  
Some Americans are Disney people  
Some Americans eat apple pie.  
Some Americans scare me the leader of the pack,  
living in this theatre  
I'm waiting for the trap to drop in the show.*

In the greater context, Squeeze has produced a cohesive album, lyrically, musically, and thematically. Squeeze has gone beyond the wickedness and slime of the people and places of mythical Babylon. The tough lives of the band's ordinary Joes and Janes are ultimately more listenable than many of the sounds coming from today's radio. ©
