Returning starters shine in scrimmage

The Oregon women's basketball team scrimmaged for the first time on Monday, and the coaching staff came away happy with the results.

Veterans Stefanie Kasperski and Sheila Sattiewhite led the yellow team to a 71-62 victory over the green team, headed by returnees Kris Glidden and Jacquie Semeniuk.

"We felt good about the scrimmage," head coach Elwin Heiny said. "The first one is always sloppy — the defense knows the offense — but we were impressed."

Kasperski led all scorers with 20 points and five rebounds, while Semeniuk scored 17 points and had six rebounds to lead the green squad.

Both of the teams shot over 50 percent from the field, and two players, Glidden and Sattiewhite, scored and rebounded in double figures. The offensive show was a welcome sign to Heiny, given that more than half of last season's offense have graduated.

"We've had somewhat of a bigger worry on offense than defense, because of the loss of (Laurie) Landerholm, (Gabi) Neumann and (Carol) Drouet," Heiny said.

However, Heiny and several of the veteran players believe the overall team play was better than last season at this time.

Glidden and Kasperski, the two returning


Forward Kris Glidden is one of two starters returning for the Duck women this season.
