Hargain gets the nod, will start at quarterback

Only three weeks ago Oregon's football team was a Pacific-10 conference contender — now the Ducks are fighting

for respectability.

Oregon, 4-4, is taking a battered, bruised squad and a three game losing streak into Tempe, Ariz., to take on Arizona State, 5-3, in front of an expected 70,000 people in Sun Devil Stadium.

The game also will be telecast locally by KEZI at 4:00 p.m.

Besides playing in front of frenzied fans and against a hungry ASU team that needs a win for post-season consideration, Oregon is forced to play freshman Tony Hargain, a second-string flanker, at quarterback because of injuries to the usual quarterbacks.

To make matters worse, the Ducks are only hopeful that their top two guns, Bill Musgrave (deep thigh bruise) and Pete Nelson (back injury) will make the trip and play backup.

That puts a lot of pressure on Hargain, who took his college snap in last weekend's embarrassing 20-6 loss to then-last-place California.

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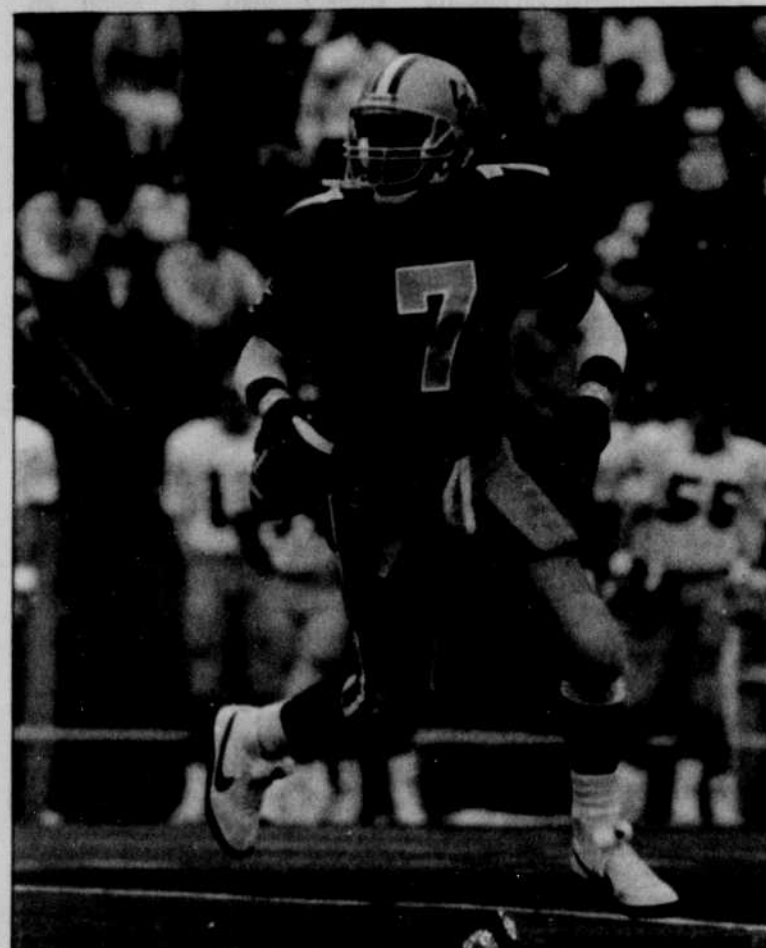
