done," Toledo said. The Oregon coaches would prefer to rest Musgrave, who suffered a deep thigh contusion in the Ducks' first play during their 20-6 homecoming loss to Cal.

The mastermind behind Oregon's passing attack has watched Nelson's fall from grace, and his recovery. "He's a great kid and a real team player, but he's also a competitor — he wants to play. Pete was a little down earlier, but I think the last

couple weeks have made him realize he has to be ready all the time, whether he is starting or backing up," Toledo said.

The Webfoot gridders have dropped four straight games to fall to 4-5, 2-4 in the Pacific-10 Conference. The pressure is squarely on Nelson's shoulders to rekindle the spark that had the entire community fired up just a month ago against the Cougars (3-5, 1-5 in the Pac-10).

Nelson, inserted into the lineup at Arizona State last week because starter Tony Hargain couldn't generate any offense, responded with his best game of the year.

Encumbered with so many pads and braces that he said "I felt more like a lineman than a quarterback out there," Nelson hit 13 of 20 passes for 169 yards and one touchdown.

Duck spikers sweep OSU

The Civil War contest between the Oregon and Oregon State volleyball teams wasn't much of a battle Thursday, as the Ducks collected their second win in as many nights, defeating the Beavers 15-5, 15-9, 15-10 at McArthur Court.

The win gives the Ducks a 15-9 overall record, 10-6 in the Pacific-10 Conference, while the struggling Beavers sink to 3-21 overall, 0-16 in the Pac-10.

From the very beginning of last night's match, the Beavers were merely bread crumbs for the hungry Ducks.

In game one, a Lauri Kre-

jcha block and a kill by the 6-foot-1 middle blocker gave Oregon a 7-1 lead. The Ducks rattled off the final six points of the game behind the serving of Teri Kramer for the win and a 1-0 match advantage.

Oregon jumped out to a 7-2 margin in the second game before the Beavs closed the gap to 11-9. Kills by Krejcha and Monica Camp got the Ducks back on track, as Oregon scored the final four points for the game.

The Beavers stayed close throughout game three, and even led 10-9 after a Tricia Becker service ace.

Oregon fought back, as the Ducks' Michele Krebsbach held serve for the final six points for the game and the match.
