secutive turnovers by both teams.

Washington State actually outgained the Ducks in total yards 416-390 and got 25 first downs to the Ducks' 19, but the turnovers staked Oregon to a big lead and later prevented WSU from getting back into the game.

Most of Oregon's yardage came on the ground, as the Ducks rushed for a season-high 209 yards on 53 carries. Loville had 63 yards at halftime before a stomach-muscle pull limited his second-half playing time. The sophomore, who went over 1,000 career rushing yards Saturday, led the Ducks with 81 yards on 21 carries.

Freshman quarterback Bill Musgrave got his first playing time in since going down against Cal. He replaced Nelson in the third quarter, but showed signs of his inactivity.

Musgrave completed only one of six passes, and the offensive play-calling was very conservative while he played, as the Ducks got just three first downs the rest of the way.

Rosenbach had his troubles throwing the ball on the bitterly cold and windy afternoon, but made up for it with his elusive scrambling. The Pullman native gained 104 yards rushing to lead the Cougars, and his tireless running took the starch out of the Duck defensive line as the game wore on.

Rosenbach, after closing the margin to 31-17, had WSU on its way to an apparent touchdown with two-and-a-half minutes left to play. He hit running back Steve Broussard with a 48-yard strike, but Broussard was stripped of the ball on his way to the end zone, and Scott Kozak pounced on the loose ball at the Oregon two-yard line.

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
