

OSPIRG asks students to fast, give money for hunger

Local groups are encouraging students to fast Thursday and donate the money saved on food to help fight world hunger.

The event is being sponsored by the Oregon Student Public Interest Research Group, ASUO, ASLCC, Council for Human Rights in Latin America (CHRLA), Clergy and Laity Concerned (CALC), Chi Omega and other student and community organizations.

The fast will last from sundown today

to sundown Thursday. Participants are asked to donate \$2.50 for each meal they skip. Those who choose to fast for 24 hours are asked for a donation of \$7.

According to Pat McAuliffe, OSPIRG hunger group coordinator, all funds raised by the project will go directly to Oxfam, an international agency that works on self-help projects in developing countries.

He added the first Oxfam was formed in England after World War II, and there are now about seven Oxfams internationally. OSPIRG has been involved with the American-based Oxfam for the last three years.

"Many people don't really know what it's like to feel hungry," McAuliffe said. "It won't kill someone to fast for a day, it will show them how it really feels."

Janet Walters, OSPIRG media coordinator for the hunger group, said that OSPIRG representative sent out letters inviting local and state representatives to participate in the project.

"So far, we have a pledge from (4th District U.S. Rep.) Peter DeFazio to fast for a day, and Sen. Larry Hill has said he will attend the dinner," she said.

The "Break-Fast" dinner will be held at the Wesley Center, 1236 Kincaid St., at 5:30 p.m. on Thursday. All food serv-

ed at the dinner has been donated by private organizations in the community.

Walters said OSPIRG will have a table in the EMU today from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. and one at the University Bookstore all day. The purpose of the tables is to sign up students to participate in the fast, she added.

The "Break-Fast" dinner will cost \$5, and is open not just to those who fast. Lauren Norris, OSPIRG local board chairwoman, said she hopes between 60 to 100 people attend the dinner.

Joel Ario, OSPIRG executive director and director of National Student Campaign Against Hunger, will speak.
