Occasionally, Saint Onge encounters frustrating situations like chair lifts that have a key located three floors down. "You feel kind of left out, and you feel

it's not available for everybody. But you reach an acceptance level. Life's too short and you figure that it was someplace you didn't need to go anyhow," she said.
