Kramer spent her freshman and sophomore seasons learning from former coach Chris Voelz, now the University's associate athletic director.

"Chris really introduced me to college volleyball. She taught me the basic skills and how to handle the pressures. Gerry's

polished my offensive and defensive skills, so I've really been able to make a good progression under those two coaches," Kramer said.

Gregory has nothing but praise for his prize outside hitter.

"Teri's made a big mark for Oregon volleyball. I would say she's in the same company as Sue (Harbour)," he said. "I

think fans will remember her for her thunderous spikes. She has a lightning-fast arm. For a female outside hitter, Teri has the strongest spike I've ever seen.

"She's also intense and very competitive, both in practice and in the matches. When the chips are down, all the players know that Teri will come up with a great play," Gregory added. "She's also been very consistent. We've nominated her

for the Pac-10 player of the week award for about 75 percent of all the weeks we've played this season."

Kramer has been chosen as the player of the week twice this season, three times in her career.

"I would like to be remembered for my enthusiasm and also as a team player — a player who was fun to watch," Kramer said.

"Volleyball's given me a chance to travel and see the country. It's made me more outgoing to play in front of thousands of people here at home, and I've also met a lot of people. It's fun to be recognized around campus."

Have no doubt that when Kramer is recognized, she will be recognized as one of the greatest players in Oregon volleyball history.

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
