College Bowl offers campus locals post-season intellectual competition

The bowl season is almost upon us, and by the new year the various post-season games will be decided and a new national football champion crowned.

Not long after these games are over however, another type of bowl season begins.

These contests don't require athletic ability, but you must be quick, versatile and intelligent. Also, above all, a contestant must have consistent teamwork to be successful in the College Bowl.

College Bowl is the resurrection of the television game show by the same name, which ran in the 1950s and 1960s. It pits two

teams of four students against each other in a question/answer contest, similar to the Trivial Pursuit board game.

"We're now seeing a revival of it on college campuses because it's geared more toward fun for students instead of strictly academic," said EMU Recreation Director Sandy Vaughn. "The initial game of college bowl was oriented toward academic subjects."

Now, College Bowl features subjects ranging from music to literature, and "just about everything is represented," Vaughn said.

College Bowl was strictly a residence hall event before the event was opened to allow for campus-wide participation two years ago.

"Last year was real suc-

cessful, we had 16 teams. Our ultimate goal would be to have every department, every fraternity and sorority, every group on campus have a team," Vaughn said.

Before the season starts, she will gather team captains together and decide the seeds for the double-elimination tournament. Then the tournament begins on Jan. 20.

After three rounds of play, eight teams will compete in the campus finals, and then it's on to the Northwest regionals at the University of Puget Sound.

Vaughn said the University usually stumbles at regionals, but this year she hopes for improvement.

"This year there will be an all-star team chosen from the campus semi-finalist teams, like the other schools do," she said.

The University games are 14 minutes long with two seven-minute halves. There are toss-up questions answered by individual team members, and bonus questions that teammates can confer on for five seconds. Point totals at the game's end determine the winner.

Teams are made up of four players with one alternative, and only two graduate students are allowed on a team. Potential teams can register at the EMU Recreation Center or any residence hall from Jan. 8 through 15. Individuals also can sign up for placement on a team at either registration location. Entry fees are \$2 per person or \$8 a team.

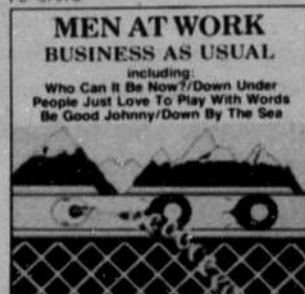

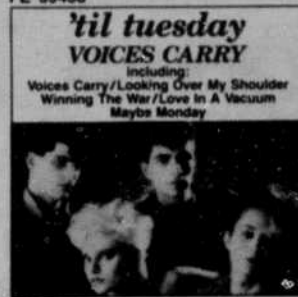
