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China, UO vow exchanges

Discussion between the Oregon State System of Higher Education representatives and its counterpart in the Chinese province of Fujian could lead to future medical and athletic exchanges between the two, according to University administrators.

Chancellor William "Bud" Davis and Yu Guanglu, deputy director of the Fujian Provincial Foreign Affairs Office, agreed that delegations between the Fujian Province and Oregon should explore the exchange of coaches and exhibitions by sports teams, and also should explore future relationships between the Oregon Health Sciences University and the Fujian Medical Institute.

The agreement, in memorandum form, was signed during a tour of the University on Thursday by a seven-member economic delegation from the Fujian province.

Both Yu and Davis agreed the higher education agreement between Oregon and Fujian Province, signed in Fuzhou, China on May 31, 1986, should be renegotiated as soon as possible.

The new agreement specifically asks that a delega-

tion of no more than five higher education faculty and administrators should visit Fujian Province early in 1988 to complete a new agreement.

The new agreement, besides asking for an exploration of athletic and medical exchanges, also should include the continuation of student, faculty, and technical exchanges provided for in the 1986 agreement.

The agreement, which covers the 1986-87 and 1987-88 school years, will be renegotiated next spring.

Yu and Davis agreed "future educational cooperation should be based upon the spirit and principle of the agreement of Dec. 7, 1984, which established a Sister Province/State relationship between Fujian Province and the State of Oregon," the memorandum stated.

The 1986 cultural exchange agreement, which has provided for the education of 19 Chinese graduate students at the University, Oregon State University, and Portland State University, also includes two groups of Oregon college students who have studied at a teacher's university in Fujian.

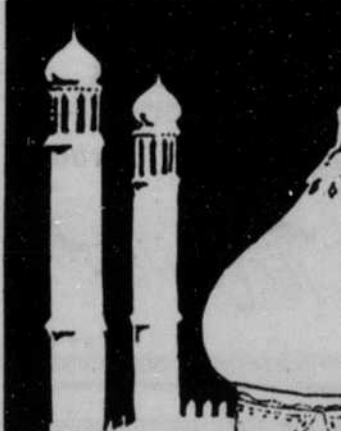
