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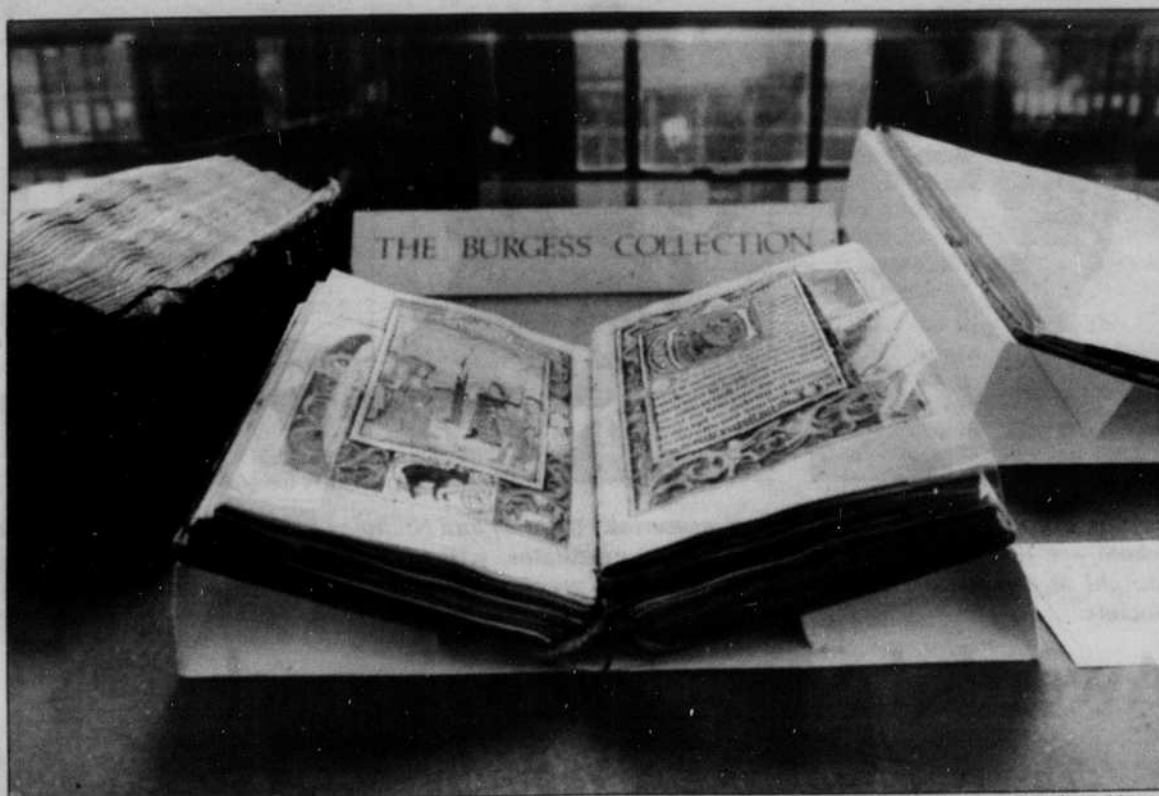

Hand-printed book display opens

A selection of rare handwritten books currently is on display in the Special Collections Department of the University's Main Library.

The 15 gilded manuscripts

and ancient printed books were selected from the more than 200 volumes of the Edward S. Burgess Collection, which has been the property of the University since 1937.

Burgess was a turn-of-the-century botanist and classical scholar who taught at Johns Hopkins University. He used his collection as source material for teaching and lecturing.

After his death, Burgess left his collection to his sister, Julia, who was a faculty member in the University's English department. She subsequently sold

part of the collection and donated the rest to the University.

The earliest manuscript in the display is an 11th-century German commentary on the works of St. Augustine. Also featured is an intricately detailed Flemish manuscript entitled "Book of Hours."

Besides the gold-leafed and splendidly illuminated manuscripts, the collection contains 53 so-called "incunabula," a word appropriately taken from Latin which means works done "in the cradle" of printing technology. Also included are many fine original and early editions of British and American authors such as Wordsworth and Emerson.

Tim Pyatt, the Special Collections librarian, explained that many of the incunabulas were written and printed on vellum, a thin, processed lamb or calf skin, which is highly resistant to deterioration over time because of its alkalinity.

Pyatt said there are source materials in this collection for dissertations on theology and history just waiting to be written. Nothing at all has ever been published on a few of these books, he added.

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
