## Student voters may pay for registering locally

Although the Lane County Elections Office encourages voter registration, it is sending out a warning to University students: If you're from out of state, think twice before signing a registration card.

The reason, explained office administrator Dave Spriggs, boils down to money.

Visiting students who vote in Lane County, then transfer to a college back home, may end up paying out-of-state tuition in their home state. Spriggs said some institutions check a returning student's voting history and, if that student registered to vote in another state's jurisdiction, he or she may be forced to pay the higher tuition rate.


"We don't like to see people

get burned by registering here," Spriggs said. "Students need to be wary."

Students from other states and counties can still vote in their home districts via absentee ballots.

Spriggs added that non-U.S. citizens may not vote in city, county, state or national elections.

The registration deadline to vote in Oregon's May 17 primary election is Tuesday at 5 p.m. All registration cards must be received at the voter registration office, 135 E. 6th Ave. Registration cards are available through banks, post offices, the Department of Motor Vehicles and various student groups on campus.
