

Strife in Middle East to be focus of lecture

The current uprisings in the West Bank and Gaza Strip will be the topic of a lecture entitled "Israel: the Diaspora of the Palestinians."

Muslim scholar Tariq Qurishi, the editor of Islamic Horizon magazine and the Al-Ittihad Journal, will speak on the subject Thursday at 7 p.m. in the EMU Fir Room.

The lecture is sponsored by the Muslim Student Association.

Qurishi, a member of the Islamic Society of North America, will discuss the

motivations behind the current uprisings and speculate on the consequences of the Israeli-Palestinian conflict.

"He is very outspoken, and knowledgeable of the situation," said Ali Alhakami of the Muslim Student Association.

"Diapsora" means something like displacement, Alhakami said in explaining the lecture's title. The lecture is to illustrate problems that are causing the conflict and clarify any misconceptions about the uprisings.

Following the lecture, there will be an opportunity for discussion and questions from the audience.

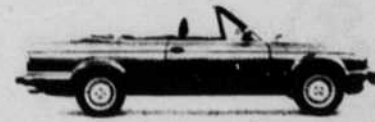

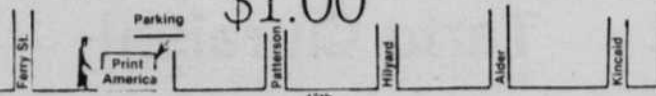
