Hovet to speak at LUNA meeting

The Lane County United Nations Association (LUNA) will hold its first public, organizational meeting at Gerlinger Alumni Lounge tonight at 7:30.

University political science professor Tom Hovet will address audiences at the meeting. Hovet was awarded the Oregon United Nations Association's First Annual Distinguished Service Award in 1982.

Hovet also was the American Civil Liberties Union representative to the U.N. from 1962 to 1968.

County Commissioner Jerry Rust also will speak at the meeting.

According to University Speakers Bureau Manager George Beres, LUNA hopes to function as a valid influential group on the U.N. and U.N. policies in the political arena.

Beres said the groups is forming because of concern over diminishing U.S. government support for the U.N., and growing criticism of the U.N. in American politics.

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
