Capital campaign advances past \$30 million mark, halfway point

The University's Campaign for Oregon Fund has edged past its halfway point with a gift of \$450,000 from University alumnus and former co-owner of the then-Oakland Raiders, Robert Braddock.

With a final goal of \$60 million, the five-year capital campaign currently stands at more than \$30 million.

The Braddock gift is designated to be divided into thirds, with \$150,000 each going to the Athletic Department, the College of Business Administration, and the fund for improvements to the University's Knight Library, according to Clifton Cole, director of planned giving for the University Foundation.

Braddock has been a long-standing booster of the University, particularly the Athletic Department and the College of Business Administration.

The gift is part of an endeavor by the Braddock family to begin supporting more programs and to become further

involved in the University's academic fields.

The Athletic Department will use the money to aid in the construction of the Len Cas-

anova Center at Autzen Stadium, while the College of Business Administration will establish a named endowment fund.

The Knight Library will continue its program of expansion and renovation.

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"This makes their gift doubly impressive in that they gave up an extraordinary property and investment for the good of the University," Olum said in mid-October after receiving the gift.

"The gift is particularly appropriate because it touches on three of the goals that have been listed for the Campaign for Oregon," Cole said. "Robert Braddock has been a long-time supporter of the University for both athletics and academics."

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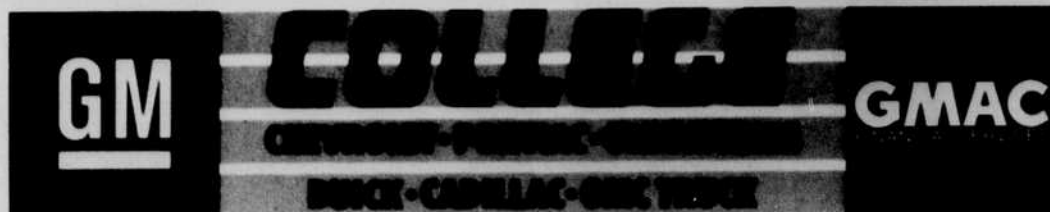
