

Booth provides bus information

To help University students and staff find efficient routes to campus, Lane Transit District has been staffing an information booth near the University Bookstore that concludes services tonight at 6.

Last term's EMU information table wasn't as effective as LTD staff had hoped, said Customer Service Manager Andy Vobora. But the booth at the 13th Avenue and Kincaid Street LTD station has done better since it opened Jan. 3 because of the bookstore's large student draw at the beginning of the term.

"We're doing a lot of route planning to help someone plan a trip from another place to the University and we're giving general departure times," Vobora said. The booth doesn't issue bus passes or sell tokens, but both are available at the bookstore and the EMU Main Desk.

With LTD ridership doubled from this time last year, the system can be confusing, said planning administrator Stefano Viggiano. "Our main intent is to answer questions and help people understand how the system works," he said.

Making more information available during the term's first week was originally the LTD drivers' idea. Last term drivers received numerous questions from student and faculty and, although they were knowledgeable about many routes, they could not provide individual route planning, Viggiano said.

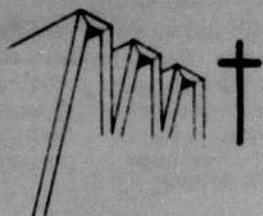
"We can't expect to hand a person a time schedule and expect them to plan their trip," Viggiano said.

LTD administrators will evaluate the effectiveness of the booth, and most likely continue staffing it at the beginning of each term, Viggiano said. After today, route information and planning help will be available at the Customer Service Center, 104 Willamette St., or with the LTD schedule information number.

Don Luce made international headlines in 1970, when he exposed the Saigon regime's "tiger cage" prison cells.

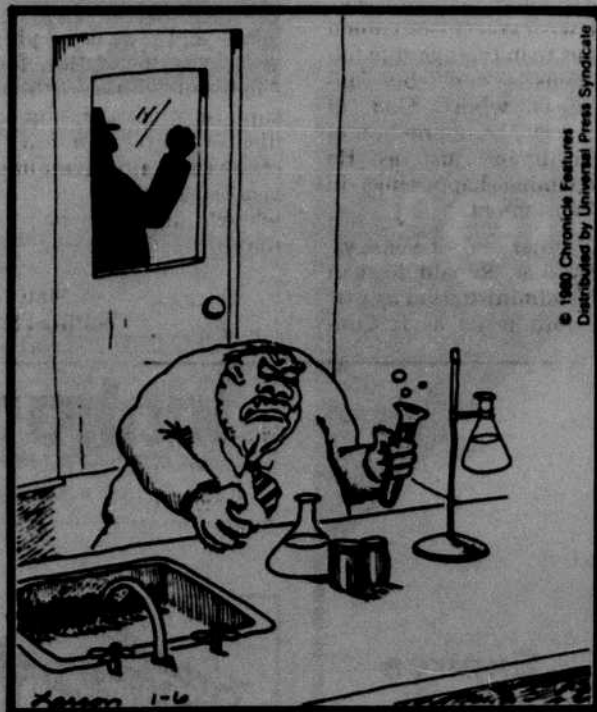
