

Ducks advance in softball tourney

The Oregon softball team defeated Bowling Green University 9-1 Thursday afternoon in the opening round of the Arizona Softball Classic in Tucson.

With the win, the Ducks run their record to 8-0 overall, 4-0 in the Pacific-10 Conference.

Sophomore Stacey Funderburg sparked a two-run first inning for Oregon, coming up with a triple that scored two.

The Ducks put up two more runs in the third, then erupted for five runs in the fifth, highlighted by freshman Sandy

Scott's two-run triple.

The Webfoots close to within one game of the school record for consecutive victories (nine) set in 1979.

Breaking the record will be no easy task, as Oregon will face a host of top-20 teams in the remainder of the tournament.

Following Thursday's win over Bowling Green, the Ducks will play fifth-ranked Long Beach State, fourth-ranked California and 19th-ranked Utah today.

DUCK NOTES:

Oregon center Stefanie Kasperski has been named to

the GTE Academic All-District team as selected by the College Sports Information Directors of America. Possessing a 3.95 grade point average in biology, last year's academic all-conference selection now becomes eligible for academic all-America consideration to be announced in March ...

Few players in the Pac-10 can match the numbers Kasperski has put up on the court, especially in the last three weeks. Highlighted by a career-high 34 points against Arizona State, the league's third-leading scorer (19.3 points per game) and second-

best rebounder (10.1) has averaged 25.0 points and 11.8 rebounds a game during that span ...

Leading the Pac-10 in field goal percentage defense (38.9 percent) and ranking third in scoring defense (67.5 points per game), the Oregon women are 7-1 when holding opponents under 80 points during the conference season and 0-3 when they are unsuccessful in doing so ...

The Willamette Valley hasn't been a pleasant place to play hoops for visiting teams in 1989, and the numbers prove it. Oregon and Oregon State have combined to post a 9-3 record (.750 winning percentage) at home in conference games. That record can only be matched by the Bay Area schools, Stanford and California (6-2).
