"The logo should have been sent through us," Jackson said. "We should also have been smart enough to catch the similarity to the Hard Rock symbol."

Because of limited resources Jackson's office is unable to continually monitor the use of University symbols, Jackson said.

The removal of the Hard Duck logo has left a void in products offered by the bookstore, but the store should come out with a new design soon, Spencer said.

"We're constantly searching for new designs," Spencer said. "We should have a new design within the next couple of months to replace the Hard Duck design."

and have educated themselves to foreign student concerns," she said.

Kim has "put a lot of energy" into developing counseling programs and workshops for foreign students this year, he said. He believes that counselors have developed a sensitivity to foreign students and skills that will continue.

The Center also addresses the needs of foreign students' families, which have additional stresses and strains, Stark said. The spouse may not have lan-

guage skills and therefore relies on the other for routine things such as shopping.

Kim offers workshops on cultural differences for these spouses, with topics including child rearing, marital problems, English and basic skills of depression management.

The counseling center is located on the second floor of the Student Health Center at 13th Avenue and Agate Street. The entrance is across from Carson Hall, and counselors can be reached at 686-3227.

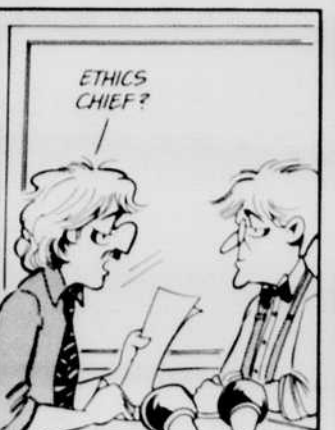
