Christic Institute founder to speak about government

Bill Davis, co-founder, chief investigator and West Coast director of the Christic Institute, will discuss covert government operations March 15 at noon in the EMU Ballroom.

The Christic Institute is a public interest law firm and policy center working to uncover the mysteries behind the Iran/Contra scandal in addition to representing victims of injustice.

The topic of Davis' talk will be "Unmasking The Shadow Government." "The shadow government is an undefined term for the (Gen. Richard) Secord enterprise ... who have become prominent in the Iran/Contra affair," Davis said.

He said he will try to show "the emergence in a larger historical context; see how the phenomena developed ... where our foreign policy is dictated through a private network."

Davis started his present in-

vestigative role in the late 1970s with the Karen Silkwood case. He then went on to co-found the Christic Institute in 1980.

He was an investigator for the father of Charles Horman, whose murder by the Chilean military in 1973 was dramatized in the film "Missing."

Six months ago, the case filed by the Christic Institute against almost a dozen people involved in Iran/Contra was dismissed by a federal judge in Miami. The institute since has filed an appeal in the 11th Circuit Court of Appeals in Atlanta.

In his speech Davis will discuss these subjects and the recent arrest of John Hull in Costa Rica, who the institute pinned with illegal activities with the CIA more than two years ago.

The talk will be sponsored by Students For Government Integrity, the Survival Center and University Democrats.

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
