After all the thank you's had been signed and delivered by the Oregon women's basketball team before Friday's Civil War contest against Oregon State, it became evident the Ducks had saved the biggest thank you for last.

The Webfoots — after thank-

ing the fans, the band, (OSU guard) Chelle Flamoe and Stefanie Kasperski (both named first team GTE Academic All-Americans), the OSU seniors and the Ducks' lone senior, Monica Camp — rewarded the season-high 1,928 fans in attendance with a nail-biting, 61-55 come-from-behind victory over the Beavers, ending their regular season at 19-10 and 11-7 in the Pacific-10 Conference.
