Bulletin lists summer internships

Your summer internship could be just a bulletin away.

A bulletin to help University students find summer employment is currently circulating to individual departments. "Paid Summer Internships" was distributed by the Career Planning and Placement Service in a response to student demands for summer employment.

"There has always been a need" for the bulletin, said Debbie Chereck, assistant director of the service. "This year we decided to follow up on the need and aid the students by starting the bulletin."

Most of the jobs listed are paid positions. A few are volunteer internships, for which academic credit can be earned. CPPS sent inquiries about in-

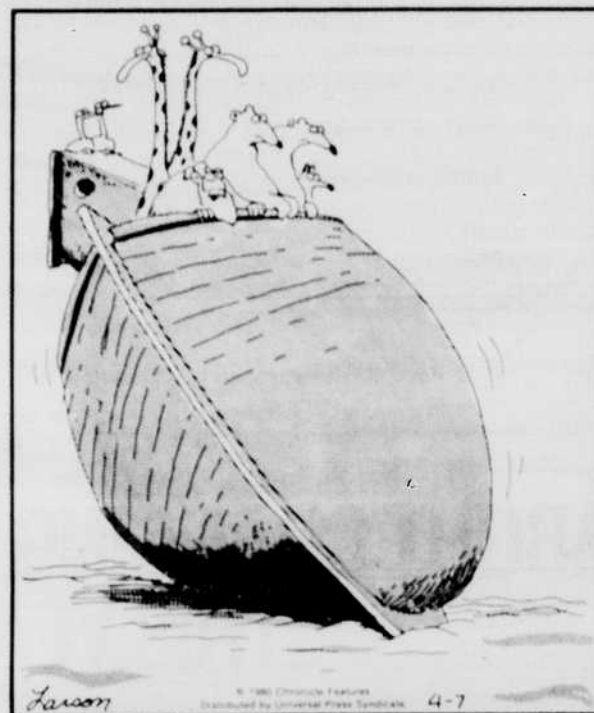
ternship positions to more than 200 Portland-based employers, including financial service companies, high-tech firms and advertising agencies. Only about 30 have responded so far, but more responses are being received every day, University officials said.

Job information in the bulletin is brief, and includes only the internship title, employer, application procedure, and application deadline. More detailed information is available in the internship notebook at the Career Information Center in 221 Hendricks Hall.

"All the opportunities included in the bulletin can potentially give students career experience, besides some sort of wage," Chereck said.
