Softballers sweep double-header

The wins are coming easier and easier for the Oregon softball team, which won four more games over the weekend, two without even stepping foot on the playing field.

The Ducks swept a conference double-header from 15th-ranked Arizona State at Howe Field on Saturday, 1-0 and 2-1, and picked up two more wins when Oregon State forfeited a non-league twin-bill Sunday afternoon because of multiple injuries on the team.

In the process, the Webfoots set a new team record with 11 consecutive victories, and upped their mark to 46-13 overall, 11-5 in the Pacific-10 Conference.

On Saturday against the Sun Devils, Oregon was involved in two one-run thrillers, coming out on the winning end in both games.

Oregon pitcher Katie Wiese (34-8) tossed a pair of two-hitters at ASU, which could manage only one run on the day after scoring 26 runs in two games with the Beavers on Fri-

day, a 13-0, 13-0 double-header sweep.

Arizona State threatened first in the opener, loading the bases with no outs in the fourth inning. But on two consecutive plays, Oregon second baseman Kristl Okuhara snagged ground balls and threw home to catcher Julie Cavanaugh for force outs, and Wiese struck out Tammy Duncan to get out of the inning unscathed.

"Cavanaugh made two excellent plays at the plate," Duck head coach Teresa Wilson said. "We had the plays where we had to have them defensively."

Moving on to the bottom of the sixth, Cavanaugh reached safely on a bunt single, took second on Kathy Gray's grounder, and scored when Oregon's Kim Manning ripped a single down the right field line for the game's only run.

"I just wanted a solid hit," said Manning, who went 2-for-2 in the first game and added a 2-for-4 effort in the nightcap. "I've been in kind of a slump the last two games."

The Ducks jumped out to a 1-0 lead in the first inning of game two, when Oregon's

Jeanna King scored on Manning's single to center.

The run held up for six innings, until ASU's Michele Gravatt hit a clutch home run in the bottom of the seventh to tie the score and send the game to extra innings.

"It was just a rise pitch," Wiese said. "It moved a little bit but not enough, and it wasn't in a good location. I do get away with a lot of dumb pitches, so I guess I'll get burned sometimes."

Manning led off the bottom of the ninth with a bunt single, and took third on Sandy Scott's deep grounder to short. Scott was safe on the play, and went to second when Sun Devil first baseman Donna Stewart threw to third in an attempt to get Manning.

ASU pitcher Terri Carnice'lli intentionally walked Tracey Simmons to load the bases with no outs, and moments later, Stacey Funderburg blooped a single to right, scoring (who else?) Manning.

"Kim's such a multi-threat," Wilson said. "She has the speed to bunt and slap hit, and

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
