

'Paper and Ashes' on display

A multi-media exhibit by three University students will be on display May 30 to June 2 in Lawrence Hall's Gallery 141.

The joint exhibit, titled "Paper and Ashes: Wood-Fired Pottery, Silver Print and Xerography," includes artwork by Jessie Morioka, Lisa Williams and Wai Kwan Chan. All three artists are University bachelor of fine arts degree candidates.

Morioka, originally from Japan, now resides in Eugene. Although her interest in clay and wood-fired pottery grows from her childhood experiences in Japan, she has experimented with the properties of locally

produced clay in her artwork.

"Pottery making for me is the story of finding the center — not only of the clay, but of my own inner balance," she said.

Chan will exhibit black-and-white landscape photographs.

Williams will exhibit photographs and xerography. Xerography uses a photocopier to produce art.

A free public reception for the artists will be held at 7 p.m. Tuesday, May 30 in the gallery.

Gallery 141 is open to the public from 9 a.m. to 4:45 p.m. Monday through Friday, except state and University holidays such as Memorial Day, May 29.
