"These gifts vary to everybody's taste," she said. "They're really just to give somebody a little something."

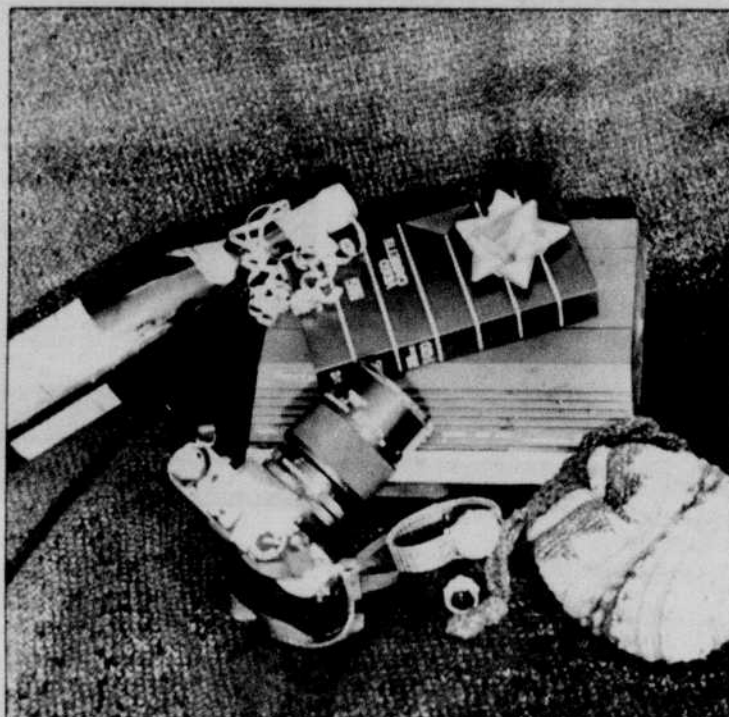
