Henzel said the game gives students with the opportunity to practice their investment skills.

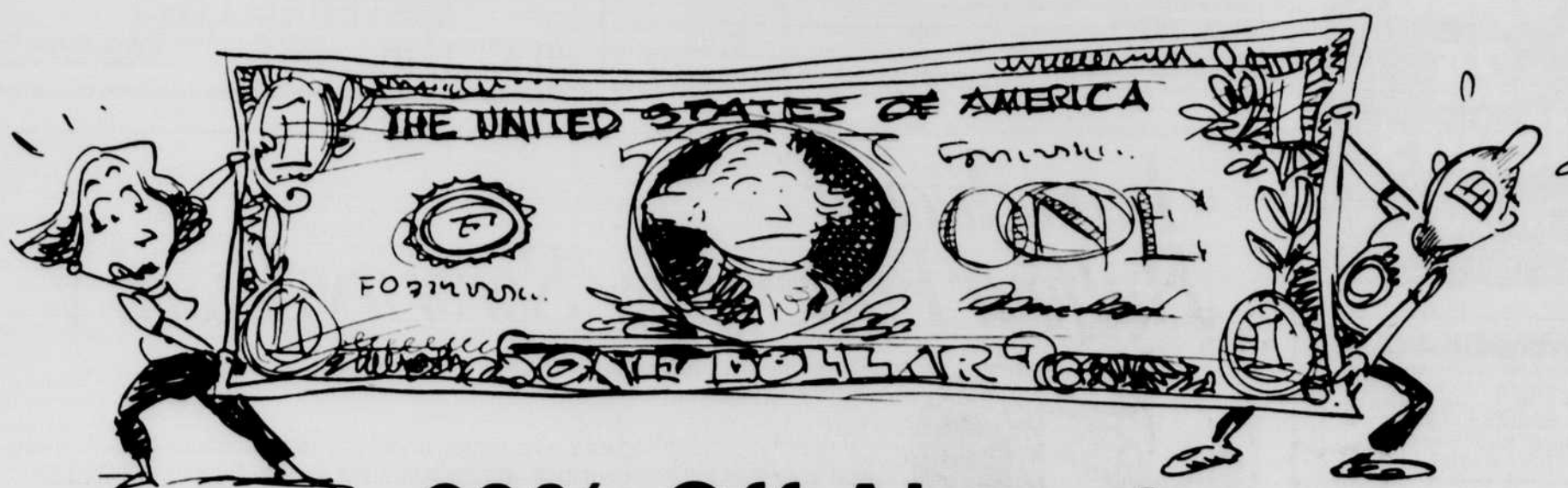
