Conduct Code covers harassment Complaints bring changes

In response to several harassment complaints on campus this year, the University's Student Conduct Code underwent several changes June 6, according to a press release by Elaine Green, acting assistant Dean of Students and Student Conduct Coordinator.

Open hearings on possible Conduct Code changes were held throughout spring term.

Previously, 18 offenses were listed in the Conduct Code for which "disciplinary action may be initiated by the University." A new punishable offense was added to the list:

"Harassment on University property or at University sponsored or supervised activities,

because of another person's race, color, gender, national origin, age, religion, marital status, disability, veteran status, or sexual orientation, or for other reasons accomplished by:

"(A.) Intentionally subjecting another person to offensive physical contact other than self-defense; or

"(B.) Specifically insulting another person in his or her immediate presence with abusive words or gestures when a reasonable person would expect that such act would cause emotional distress or provoke a violent response."

Any student or student organization found guilty of committing, attempting to commit, or intentionally assisting in any of the 19 offenses listed in the Student Conduct Code could

face one or more disciplinary sanctions.

These sanctions include expulsion, suspension, negative notation on transcript, disciplinary probation, restitution, community service, loss of privileges or conduct reprimand.

Another change in the Conduct Code falls under the category of academic dishonesty cases where the case is contested by the student. Changes in the wording appear below in quotations:

If a student challenges the academic dishonesty charge "of which he or she is accused at the student/faculty conference," the student may and the faculty member shall, not later than "two weeks after the date of the conference," make a written referral of the case to the Coordinator of Student Conduct for resolution.

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EMU limits hours

The University is considerably less busy during summer term, something reflected by the EMU's summer hours.

Until the eight-week class session ends in mid-August, the student union will be open from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday through Thursday, and from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Friday. The building will be closed on weekends.

When the session ends Aug. 11, the EMU will be open from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday, and closed on weekends. The building will also be closed on July 4 and Labor Day weekend (Sept. 2-4).

Regular hours will resume Sept. 17.

The EMU will lengthen its hours to accommodate special conferences and events, said Virginia Anderson, University scheduling officer. Doors will remain open from 7 a.m. to 9 p.m. for the World Veterans Championships, to be held from July 27 to Aug. 5. Extended hours will also be offered for events such as computer conferences and the Greens Party conference, Anderson said.



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
