Buster Goes Berserk is full of rocking blues and funk music

Got to whip yourself together and knock the corners off the squares (Buster Poindexter, "DeBourge Yourself").

You just can't argue with the basic idea behind Buster Poindexter's music: get together a tight blues/funk band, a strong

backup chorus, a bodacious horn section and make an album of full-tilt boogie.

Poindexter (formerly David Johansen, of the nihilist transvestite quartet New York Dolls) and his Banshees of Blue have done just that on *Buster Goes Berserk*, the follow-up to *Buster Poindexter*, which *Rolling Stone* called the best party album of 1987.

On seven of the album's ten tracks, bassist Tony 'Antoine Fats' Garnier, drummer Tony Machine, and percussionist Fred Walcott lay down some of the funkier, party-ready sound anybody would want. Into this grinding, grooving framework, Poindexter pours his own charged lyrics, the hot harmonies of dozens of back-up vocalists, and the raucous brass of the Uptown Horns.

On the opening track, "All Night Party," the formula works like magic, with Poindexter's affected Afro-Caribbean vocals playing off the sweet high harmonies of the cast of the critically acclaimed South African revue "Sarafina!" The sound is reminiscent of "Gumboots" from Paul Simon's South African influenced *Graceland*. As a party tune, it's beyond reproach.

"Hit the Road, Jack," which accompanied the film *The*

Dream Team, is a mercilessly strutting remake of Curtis Mayfield's classic. It's not as likely to set a room in motion as "All Night Party," but it'll do. The band and vocalists answer Poindexter's rap-tinged vocals in fine Cab Calloway/Louis Jordan style.

"International Playboy" is the most traditional R&B funk track on the album, and here Poindexter sounds to the nightclub born, belting out lyrics with a vengeance. The tight horn and rhythm lines evoke

the big-band Chicago sound and early Tower of Power records.

The show-pieces of the album are "Who Threw the Whiskey in the Well," a vicious send-up of gospel which opens the second side, and "DeBourge Yourself," an anti-bourgeoisie funk number.

"Who Threw the Whiskey in the Well" allows Poindexter's tongue-in-cheek singing style full rein and provides the
