Oregon announced a national search for a new coach, and Walker said last week that applications have come in from Tennessee, South Carolina, Creighton University, and "several from California."

Walker said that all applications will be reviewed by a four-member committee, including herself; Sandy Walton, assistant athletic director; Gary Gray, athletic department academic coordinator; and softball player Kelly Finley, representing the team.

Walker said within the next two weeks the committee will narrow its choices down to "a final three or a final five," and those applicants will be interviewed at that time.

leased, but two of the applicants are believed to be Arizona State Assistant Tami Brown and Central Arizona Coach Clint Myers.

Brown played at ASU from 1981-84, earning all-conference honors in 1982 and 1984. The Red Bluff, Calif., native has

coaching experience from her stint as Stanford's head coach in 1987 when the Cardinal varsity team moved to club status. Stanford, which was 5-36 in 1986, finished 25-5 in 1987, the best record in team history.

Rittman has indicated that his name will also remain in the ring, and Oregon players have said that if needed, he will return.

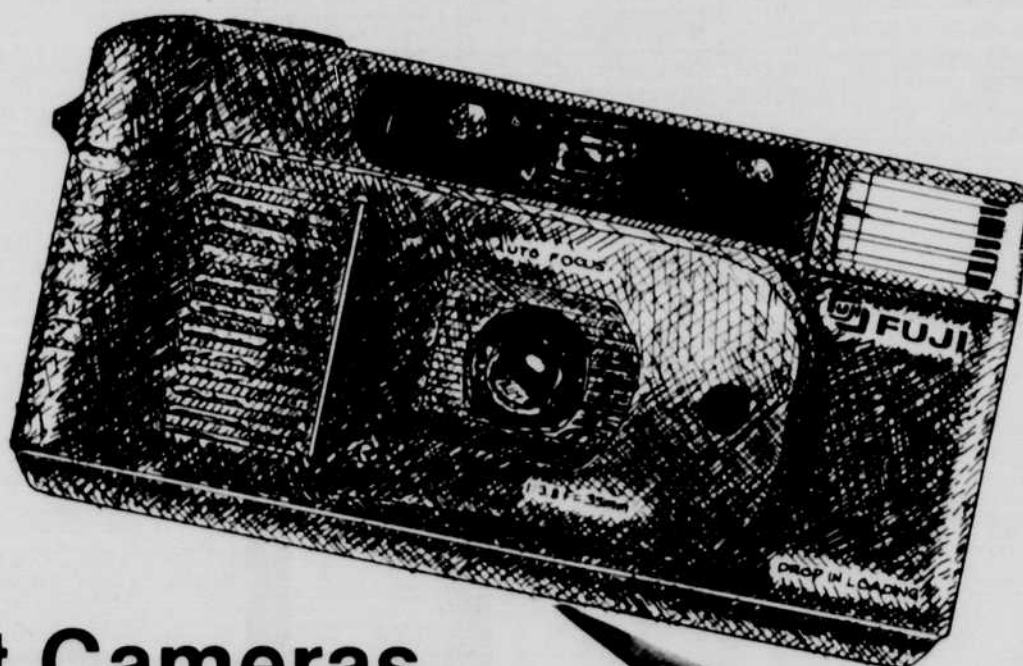
